An act to amend Section 16430 of the Penal Code, relating to deadly weapons.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1009, as introduced, Mansoor. Deadly weapons: definition.

Existing law defines a deadly weapon as any weapon, the possession or concealed carrying of which is prohibited by any specified provisions of law.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16430 of the Penal Code is amended to

4 of Title 2, "deadly weapon" means any weapon, the possession or
5 concealed carrying of which is prohibited by any ~~provision~~ *of the*
6 *provisions* listed in Section 16590.
