An act to add Section 66027.5 to the Education Code, relating to public postsecondary education.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1025, as amended, Garcia. ~~Postsecondary~~ *Public postsecondary education: College-level examination programs: credit by examination.*

Existing law establishes 3 segments of public postsecondary education in the state, the California State University, administered by the Trustees of the California State University, the California Community Colleges, administered by the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, and the University of California, administered by the Regents of the University of California.

This bill would ~~express the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation relating to the state use of college-level examination program credits~~ *require the California Community Colleges and the California State University, and request the Regents of the University of California, to provide information about credit by examination opportunities wherever course and class information is available.*

By imposing additional requirements on community college districts, the bill would impose a state-mandated local program.

The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state.

Statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement.

This bill would provide that, if the Commission on State Mandates determines that the bill contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement for those costs shall be made pursuant to these statutory provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 66027.5 is added to the Education Code,
2 to read:

3 66027.5. (a) The California Community Colleges and the
4 California State University shall provide information about credit
5 by examination opportunities wherever course and class
6 information is available.

7 (b) The Regents of the University of California are requested
8 to provide information about credit by examination opportunities
9 wherever course and class information is available.

10 SEC. 2. If the Commission on State Mandates determines that
11 this act contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement to
12 local agencies and school districts for those costs shall be made
13 pursuant to Part 7 (commencing with Section 17500) of Division
14 4 of Title 2 of the Government Code.
