An act to amend Section 17515 of the Education Code, relating to public schools.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1261, as introduced, Gorell. Public schools: school facilities.

Existing law authorizes a school district to enter into leases and agreements relating to real property and buildings to be used jointly by the district and any private person, firm, local government agency, as defined, or corporation, pursuant to specified provisions.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes in that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17515 of the Education Code is amended

3 17515. ~~Any~~(a) Any school district may enter into leases and
4 agreements relating to real property and buildings to be used jointly
5 by the district and any private person, firm, local governmental
6 agency, as defined in paragraph (3) of subdivision (f) of Section
7 4420 of the Government Code, or corporation pursuant to this
8 article. As used in this article, "building" includes onsite and offsite
9 facilities, utilities and improvements that, as agreed upon by the
10 parties, are appropriate for the proper operation or function of the

1 building to be occupied jointly by the district and the private
2 person, firm, or corporation. It also includes the permanent
3 improvement of school grounds.

5 (b) Any building, or portion thereof, that is used by a private
6 person, firm, local governmental agency, as defined in paragraph
7 (3) of subdivision (f) of Section 4420 of the Government Code,
8 or corporation pursuant to this section shall be subject to the zoning
9 and building code requirements of the local jurisdiction in which
10 the building is situated.

14 buildings authorized by this section, except in the case of property
