An act to amend Section 9164 of the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to diseased animals.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1319, as introduced, Eggman. Diseased animals and poultry.

Existing law provides for the regulation of animals and pests for the prevention and control of disease. Existing law makes it unlawful for any person that does not have a written permit issued by the Secretary of Food and Agriculture to remove livestock from slaughterhouse pens, yards, corrals, or similar holding places where livestock is held for immediate slaughter, except as specified.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9164 of the Food and Agricultural Code
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 9164. In order to prevent the spread of any livestock disease,
- 4 it is unlawful for any person, ~~that~~ *who* does not have a written
- 5 permit issued by the ~~director~~, *secretary* to remove, or cause to be
- 6 removed, any livestock from slaughterhouse pens, yards, corrals,
- 7 or similar holding places where livestock is held for the purpose

- 1 of immediate slaughter, except directly into the slaughterhouse
- 2 that controls ~~such~~ *the* pens, yards, corrals, or similar holding places.
