An act to add Section 6102 to the Government Code, relating to state government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1627, as introduced, Gomez. Fees for state services.

Existing law prohibits an officer of the state from performing an official service, unless the fees prescribed by law for the performance of the service have been paid, except as specified.

This bill would prohibit an individual from charging a fee for performing or facilitating the performance of a service that the state performs for the public without a cost or fee, unless the individual discloses that the state does not charge a fee for providing that service.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6102 is added to the Government Code,
- 2 to read:
- 3 6102. Notwithstanding any other law, an individual shall not
- 4 charge a fee for performing or facilitating the performance of a
- 5 service that the state performs for the public without a cost or fee,

- 1 unless the individual discloses that the state does not charge a fee
- 2 for providing that service.
