An act to amend Section 19420 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to horse racing.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1695, as introduced, Waldron. Horse racing.

Existing law vests in the California Horse Racing Board jurisdiction and supervision over meetings in this state where horse races with wagering on their results are held or conducted, and over all persons or things having to do with the operation of those meetings.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 19420 of the Business and Professions
- 2 Code is amended to read:
