An act to amend Section 5021 of the Public Resources Code, relating to historical resources.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2081, as introduced, Daly. Historical resources.

Existing law establishes the State Historical Resources Commission and the California Register of Historical Resources. Existing law requires the Department of Parks and Recreation to consider all recommendations for registration made by the commission, and requires the department to register, as state historical landmarks, those buildings, structures, sites, or places that the department deems to be important historical resources.

This bill would provide that, for these purposes, the term places includes, but is not limited to, vineyards, orchards, and groves.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5021 of the Public Resources Code is

3 5021. (a) The department shall consider all recommendations
4 for registration made by the commission, and shall register, as
5 state historical landmarks, those buildings, structures, sites, or
6 places ~~which~~ that the department deems to be important historical

1 resources and shall register, as points of historical interest, those
2 buildings, structures, sites, or places ~~which~~ *that* the department
3 deems to be historical resources of sufficient historical interest to
4 qualify for the placement of signs pursuant to Section 5022.5. The
5 commission shall maintain a register ~~which~~ *that* shall identify by
6 number and description ~~such~~ historical landmarks and points of
7 historical interest.

9 *(b) The* department may publish results of office and field
10 archaeological investigation annually and shall issue additional
11 publications, such as detailed site reports and area resource reports,
12 as necessary, to inform the public and educational institutions.

14 *not limited to, vineyards, orchards, and groves.*
