An act to amend Section 44936 of the Education Code, relating to school employees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2333, as introduced, Wilk. School employees: discipline: suspension and dismissal.

Existing law authorizes the governing board of a school district to give notice to a permanent employee of its intention to dismiss or suspend him or her for specified causes at the expiration of 30 days from the date of service of the notice, unless the employee demands a hearing. Existing law prohibits that notice from being given between May 15th and September 15th in any year.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to the provision that prohibits the notice from being given between May 15th and September 15th in any year.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 44936 of the Education Code is amended
- 2 to read:
- 3 44936. The notice of dismissal or suspension in a proceeding
- 4 initiated pursuant to Section 44934 shall not be given between
- 5 May 15th and September 15th in any year. It shall be in writing

1 and be served upon the employee personally or by United States  
2 registered mail addressed to ~~him at his~~ *the employee at his or her*  
3 last known address. A copy of the charges filed, containing the  
4 information required by Section 11503 of the Government Code,  
5 together with a copy of the provisions of this article, shall be  
6 attached to the notice.
