Introduced by Assembly Member Morrell

An act to amend Section 3070 of the Labor Code, relating to the California Apprenticeship Council.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2460, as introduced, Morrell. California Apprenticeship Council: membership.

Existing law establishes in the Division of Apprenticeship Standards a California Apprenticeship Council, specifies its membership, and establishes the amount of reimbursement to a member for his or her attendance at a specified meeting or hearing together with his or her actual and necessary travel expenses incurred in connection with that meeting or hearing.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3070 of the Labor Code is amended to
2 read:
3 3070. There is *established* in the Division of Apprenticeship
4 Standards the California Apprenticeship Council, which shall be
5 appointed by the Governor, composed of six representatives each
6 from employers or employer organizations and employee
7 organizations, that sponsor apprenticeship programs under this

1 chapter, respectively, geographically selected, and of two
2 representatives of the general public. The Director of Industrial
3 Relations, or his or her permanent and best qualified designee, and
4 the Superintendent of Public Instruction, or his or her permanent
5 and best qualified designee, and the Chancellor of the California
6 Community Colleges, or his or her permanent and best qualified
7 designee, shall also be members of the California Apprenticeship
8 Council. The chairperson shall be elected by vote of the California
9 Apprenticeship Council. Beginning with appointments in 1985,
10 three representatives each of employers and employees, and one
11 public representative shall serve until January 15, 1989. In 1987,
12 three representatives each of the employers and employees, and
13 one public representative shall serve until January 15, 1991. Any
14 member whose term expires on January 15, 1986, shall continue
15 to serve until January 15, 1987. Thereafter each member shall
16 serve for a term of four years. Any member appointed to fill a
17 vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term of his or her
18 predecessor shall be appointed for the remainder of that term. Each
19 member of the council shall receive the sum of one hundred dollars
20 (\$100) for each day of actual attendance at meetings of the council,
21 for each day of actual attendance at hearings by the council or a
22 committee thereof pursuant to Section 3082, and for each day of
23 actual attendance at meetings of other committees established by
24 the council and approved by the Director of Industrial Relations,
25 together with his or her actual and necessary traveling expenses
26 incurred in connection therewith.
