An act to amend Section 9201 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2551, as introduced, Wilk. Local initiatives.

Existing law allows a proposed ordinance to be submitted to the legislative body of the city by a petition filed with the elections official of the legislative body, as provided, after being signed by not less than a specified number of voters.

This bill would a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9201 of the Elections Code is amended
2 to read:
3 9201. ~~Any~~A proposed ordinance may be submitted to the
4 legislative body of the city by a petition filed with the elections
5 official of the legislative body, in the manner hereinafter prescribed,
6 after being signed by not less than the number of voters specified
7 in this article. The petition may be in separate sections, providing
8 that the petition complies with this article. The first page of each
9 section shall contain the title of the petition and the text of the

- 1 measure. The petition sections shall be designated in the manner
- 2 set forth in Section 9020.
