An act to add and repeal Section 25230 of the Public Resources Code, relating to energy.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2597, as introduced, Ting. Energy: electric vehicles: grid impact.

Existing law establishes the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission and requires the commission to conduct assessments and forecasts of all aspects of energy industry supply, production, transportation, delivery, and distribution.

This bill would require the commission, on or before December 1, 2015, to submit a report to the Legislature on the feasibility, potential benefits, and electrical grid impacts of using electric vehicles as an energy storage device for meeting load demands placed on the electrical grid. The bill would repeal this provision on January 1, 2020.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 25230 is added to the Public Resources
- 2 Code, to read:
- 3 25230. (a) On or before December 1, 2015, the commission
- 4 shall, pursuant to Section 9795 of the Government Code, submit
- 5 to the Legislature a report on the feasibility, potential benefits, and
- 6 electrical grid impacts of using electric vehicles as an energy

3 (b) Pursuant to Section 10231.5 of the Government Code, this
4 section is inoperative on December 1, 2019, and is repealed on
5 January 1, 2020.

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
