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**Introduced by Assembly Member Quirk-Silva**

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An act to amend Section 12096.2 of the Government Code, relating to state government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2713, as introduced, Quirk-Silva. Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development.

The Economic Revitalization Act establishes the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development, also known as "GO-Biz," to, among other duties, serve the Governor as the lead entity for economic strategy and the marketing of California on issues relating to business development, private sector investment, and economic growth.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to this provision.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12096.2 of the Government Code is  
2 amended to read:  
3 12096.2. (a) The Governor's Office of Business and Economic  
4 Development, also known as "GO-Biz," is ~~hereby~~ established in  
5 state government within the Governor's office. The office shall  
6 be under the direct control of a director, who shall be responsible  
7 to the Governor.

1 (b) The Governor shall appoint the Director of the Governor's  
2 Office of Business and Economic Development ~~who shall~~ to  
3 perform all duties, exercise all powers, assume and discharge all  
4 responsibilities, and carry out and effect all purposes vested by  
5 law in the office, including contracting for professional or  
6 consultant services in connection with the work of the office.

7 (c) The salary of the Director of the Governor's Office of  
8 Business and Economic Development shall be fixed pursuant to  
9 Section 12001.

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
