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An act relating to coastal resources.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 257, as introduced, Hancock. Coastal resources: physical adaptations to climate change.

The California Coastal Act of 1976 requires the California Coastal Commission to implement and administer various coastal protection programs in the state, and requires any person undertaking development in the coastal zone to obtain a coastal development permit issued by the commission in accordance with prescribed procedures.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact subsequent legislation that would address the issue of coastal physical adaptations to climate change.
