An act to amend Section 8564 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to structural pest control operators.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 748, as introduced, Galgiani. Structural pest control operators.

Existing law establishes licensing provisions for structural pest control operators, as specified. Existing law requires an applicant for an original field representative's license to submit a written application to the registrar of the structural pest control board, as specified.

This bill would make a technical nonsubstantive change to those provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8564 of the Business and Professions
2 Code is amended to read:
3 8564. ~~To~~*In order to* obtain an original field representative's
4 license, an applicant shall submit to the registrar an application in
5 writing containing a statement that the applicant desires the
6 issuance of a field representative's license under the terms of this
7 chapter.
8 The application shall be made on a form prescribed by the board
9 and issued by the registrar in accordance with rules and regulations
10 adopted by the board, and shall contain the following:

- 1 (a) The length of time during which the applicant has engaged
- 2 in any work relating to pest control.
- 3 (b) The name and place of business of the person who last
- 4 employed him or her.
- 5 (c) The name of the person by whom the applicant is employed.
- 6 (d) The name of the registered company by which the applicant
- 7 is to be employed.
- 8 (e) The fees prescribed by this chapter.

9 The board shall not accept any application for a field
10 representative's license in Branch 1 unless the applicant submits
11 proof satisfactory to the board that he or she has had six months'
12 training and experience in the practice of fumigating with
13 poisonous or lethal gases under the immediate supervision of an
14 individual licensed to practice fumigating, or the equivalent of that
15 training and experience.

16 The board shall not accept any application for a field
17 representative's license in Branch 2 unless the applicant submits
18 proof satisfactory to the board that he or she has had training and
19 experience in the practice of pesticide application, Branch 2 pest
20 identification and biology, pesticide application equipment, and
21 pesticide hazards and safety practice under the immediate
22 supervision of an operator or field representative licensed in Branch
23 2, or the equivalent of that training and experience.

24 The board shall not accept any application for a field
25 representative's license in Branch 3 unless the applicant submits
26 proof satisfactory to the board that he or she has had training and
27 experience in the practice of pesticide application, Branch 3 pest
28 identification and biology, pesticide application equipment,
29 pesticide hazards and safety practices, structural repairs, and
30 structural inspection procedures and report writing under the
31 immediate supervision of an operator or field representative
32 licensed in Branch 3, or the equivalent of that training and
33 experience.
