An act to amend Section 1600 of the Fish and Game Code, relating to fish and wildlife.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 764, as introduced, Yee. Fish and wildlife protection.

Existing law declares that the protection and conservation of the fish and wildlife resources of this state are of utmost public interest.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1600 of the Fish and Game Code is
2 amended to read:
3 1600. The Legislature finds and declares that the protection
4 and conservation of the fish and wildlife resources of this state are
5 of utmost public interest. Fish and wildlife are the property of the
6 people and provide a major contribution to the economy of the
7 state, as well as providing a significant part of the people's food
8 supply; therefore ~~their~~ *the conservation of fish and wildlife* is a
9 proper responsibility of the state. This chapter is enacted to provide
10 conservation for these resources.
