LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 21, as introduced, Obernolte. Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway.

This measure would designate a specified portion of State Highway Route 18 in the County of San Bernadino as the Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway. Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate thereof concurring, That the Legislature hereby designates the portion of State Highway Route 18 in the County of San Bernardino, beginning at the intersection of State Highway Route 18 and State Highway Route 330 and continuing toward Big Bear Lake for 4.5 miles, as the Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway; and be it further

Resolved, That the Department of Transportation is requested to determine the cost of erecting the appropriate signs, consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway system, showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs; and be it further

Resolved, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies of this resolution to the Director of Transportation and to the author for appropriate distribution.
