Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 21—Relative to the Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL’S DIGEST

ACR 21, as introduced, Obernolte. Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway.

This measure would designate a specified portion of State Highway Route 18 in the County of San Bernadino as the Rim of the World Veterans Memorial Highway. The measure would request that the Department of Transportation determine the cost of appropriate signs showing this special designations and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

1 WHEREAS, Nearly two million veterans reside in the State of
2 California, and the San Bernardino Mountains are home to many
3 of these brave and honorable individuals; and
4 WHEREAS, The American Legion Post 360 and the Veterans
5 of Foreign Wars Post 9624 have partnered to sponsor the “Rim of
6 the World Veterans Memorial Highway” designation in honor of
7 those who have dedicated their lives to the service of this nation;
8 and
9 WHEREAS, Naming a highway is but a small way to
10 demonstrate our gratitude to the brave men and women who put

1 their lives on the line so that we may enjoy the freedoms of this
2 great nation; and

3 WHEREAS, We should make it a priority to fully support our
4 state's veterans in ways that commemorate their great sacrifice;
5 now, therefore, be it

6 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
7 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature hereby designates the
8 portion of State Highway Route 18 in the County of San
9 Bernardino, beginning at the intersection of State Highway Route
10 18 and State Highway Route 330 and continuing toward Big Bear
11 Lake for 4.5 miles, as the Rim of the World Veterans Memorial
12 Highway; and be it further

13 *Resolved*, That the Department of Transportation is requested
14 to determine the cost of erecting the appropriate signs, consistent
15 with the signing requirements for the state highway system,
16 showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations
17 from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs; and
18 be it further

19 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
20 of this resolution to the Director of Transportation and to the author
21 for appropriate distribution.
