WHEREAS, Young professionals have partnered with business and community leaders to promote and create a viable and livable place for young professionals; and

WHEREAS, Young professionals will convene the second annual Young Professionals Summit on March 27, 2015; and

WHEREAS, This summit will provide social, philanthropic, professional, and civic development opportunities; and

WHEREAS, The accomplishments of young professionals deserve acknowledgment, affirmation, and celebration by the State of California; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate thereof concurring, That the Legislature hereby proclaims the month of March 2015 as the Month of the Young Professional; and be it further
