### LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 30, as amended, Irwin. Armed Forces Day.

This measure would honor and recognize the service and sacrifice made by members of the Armed Forces and their families on the occasion of Armed Forces Day on May 16, 2015.

1 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day was created in 1949 in  
2 connection with the consolidation of the military services in the  
3 United States Department of Defense; and

4 WHEREAS, The purpose of Armed Forces Day is to honor the  
5 men and women who are serving in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps,  
6 Air Force, and Coast Guard, including the National Guard and  
7 Reserve components; and

8 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day is celebrated on the third  
9 Saturday in May, which this year is May 16, 2015; and

10 WHEREAS, Members of the Armed Forces have performed  
11 tremendous service on behalf of the United States; and

12 WHEREAS, Members of the Armed Forces have been injured  
13 and killed in operations to bring peace and stability in the name  
14 of democracy; and

15 WHEREAS, All Americans appreciate the sacrifices of those  
16 who bravely serve our country, and acknowledge those businesses  
17 and employers that accommodate those service people who are  
18 called abroad to defend their nation; and

19 WHEREAS, All Americans express their recognition and  
20 gratitude for members of the Armed Forces at home and abroad;  
21 now, therefore, be it

22 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*  
23 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature, on the occasion of Armed  
24 Forces Day 2015;

25 (1) Honors and recognizes the service and sacrifice that members  
26 of the Armed Forces and their families gave, and continue to give,  
27 to the United States;

28 (2) Remains committed to supporting the members of the Armed  
29 Forces and their families;

30 (3) Encourages Americans to show their support and  
31 appreciation for members of the Armed Forces on Armed Forces  
32 Day;

33 (4) Commends the actions of private citizens and organizations  
34 who volunteer to support America's wounded warriors; and

35 (5) Expresses the gratitude of the American people to the  
36 members of the Armed Forces for their service on behalf of the  
37 United States; and be it further
