House Resolution No. 14—Relative to Assembly Rule 49.

1 WHEREAS, It is the intent of the Legislature to improve the  
2 management of legislative proposals and enhance the deliberative  
3 process inherent in considering changes in law; and

4 WHEREAS, In the 2013–14 Regular Session there were 4,786  
5 bills and resolutions introduced in the Assembly and Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, In the 2013–14 Regular Session there were 1,738  
7 bills passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Under Rule 49 of the Standing Rules of the  
10 Assembly, a Member of the California State Assembly may not  
11 introduce more than 40 bills in a legislative session; and

12 WHEREAS, It is the intent of the Legislature to improve public  
13 engagement in the legislative process by further limiting the  
14 volume of proposals considered in a legislative session in order to  
15 allow constituents to more easily monitor and participate in the  
16 work of the Legislature; and

17 WHEREAS, The Legislature has determined that a limit of 30  
18 bills per Member will further the intent to improve public  
19 engagement while allowing sufficient opportunity to address  
20 district and statewide issues; and

21 WHEREAS, To prevent an unfair impact on Members working  
22 under the existing limit of 40 bills per session, the Legislature has  
23 determined that the aforementioned limit should be implemented  
24 over the next two years, with the 30-bill limit taking effect in the

1 2017–18 Regular Session, should that Legislature seek to continue  
2 this effort; now, therefore, be it

3 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, That Rule*  
4 *49 of the Standing Rules of the Assembly for the 2015–16 Regular*  
5 *Session is amended to read:*

7 Limitation on the Introduction of Bills  
8

9 49. (a) A Member may introduce not more than ~~40~~ 30 bills in  
10 the regular session. As used in this rule, “bills” includes  
11 constitutional amendments.

12 (b) Notwithstanding subdivision (a) of this rule, a Member may  
13 introduce not more than five resolutions in the regular session. As  
14 used in this rule, “resolutions” include House, Concurrent, and  
15 Joint Resolutions, but do not include resolutions introduced by a  
16 Member for the specific purpose of organizing a session that is  
17 convened pursuant to *subdivision (a) of Section 3 of Article IV;*  
18 ~~Section 3(a)~~ of the ~~State~~ *California* Constitution or resolutions  
19 introduced by the Speaker as part of a session honoring a retiring  
20 Assembly Member.

21 (c) This rule may be suspended with respect to a particular bill  
22 or resolution by approval of the Committee on Rules.

23 (d) *This rule does not apply to a bill that would take effect*  
24 *immediately as an urgency statute.*
