House Resolution No. 31—Relative to Life Insurance Awareness Month.

1 WHEREAS, Life insurance is an essential part of a sound financial plan; and

3 WHEREAS, Life insurance provides financial security for families in the event of a premature death by helping surviving 4 family members to meet immediate and long-term financial 5 obligations and objectives; and 6

WHEREAS, Nearly 95 million Americans lack life insurance coverage needed to ensure a secure financial future for their loved ones: and

WHEREAS, Each year, the life insurance industry pays \$63,000,000,000 to beneficiaries, providing a source of financial relief and security to families that experience the loss of a loved one: and

WHEREAS, Recent studies have found that when a premature death occurs, insufficient life insurance coverage on the part of the insured results in three-fourths of surviving family members having to take measures such as work additional jobs or longer hours, borrow money, withdraw money from savings and investment accounts, and, in too many cases, move to smaller, less expensive housing; and

WHEREAS, Individuals, families, and businesses can benefit greatly from professional insurance and financial planning advice,

including the assessment of their life insurance needs; and
