An act to amend Section 5401 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to charter-party carriers of passengers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 62, as introduced, Travis Allen. Charter-party carriers of passengers.

The Passenger Charter-Party Carriers' Act provides for the regulation by the Public Utilities Commission of motor carriers operating as charter-party carriers of passengers. Existing law generally requires charges for the transportation to be offered or afforded by a charter-party carrier of passengers to be computed and assessed on a vehicle mileage or time-of-use basis, rather than on an individual-fare basis, subject to certain exceptions.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5401 of the Public Utilities Code is
2 amended to read:
3 5401. Charges for the transportation to be offered or afforded
4 by a charter-party carrier of passengers shall be computed and
5 assessed on a vehicle mileage or time of use basis, or on a
6 combination thereof. These charges may vary in accordance with

1 the passenger capacity of the vehicle, or the size of the group to
2 be transported. However, no charter-party carrier of passengers
3 shall, directly or through an agent or otherwise, nor shall any
4 broker, contract, agree, or arrange to charge, or demand or receive
5 compensation, for the transportation offered or afforded that shall
6 be computed, charged, or assessed on an individual-fare basis,
7 except schoolbus contractors who are compensated by parents of
8 children attending public, private, or parochial schools and except
9 operators of ~~round-trip~~ *round trip* sightseeing tour services
10 conducted under a certificate subject to Section ~~5371.1~~, *5371.1* or
11 a permit issued pursuant to subdivision (c) of Section 5384.
