LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 70, as introduced, Waldron. Medi-Cal: hospital reimbursement. Existing law provides for the Medi-Cal program, which is administered by the State Department of Health Care Services and under which qualified low-income persons receive health care benefits. Existing law declares the intent of the Legislature to enact a method for reimbursing hospitals for inpatient and outpatient services provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries on a prospectively negotiated contractual basis and to develop and test alternatives that would become the basis for a permanent contracting system.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that statement of intent.
