Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 177—Relative to the Solano County Deputy Sheriff Hale Humphrey Memorial Highway.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 177, as amended, Frazier. Solano County Deputy Sheriff Hale Humphrey Memorial Highway.

This measure would designate a specified portion of State Highway *Route* 12 *between Marina Boulevard and Pennsylvania Avenue* in the County of Solano as the Solano County Deputy Sheriff Hale Humphrey Memorial Highway. The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost of appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

- WHEREAS, Hale Humphrey grew up in the New Boston area
- 2 of eastern Texas prior to enlisting in the United States Navy; and
- WHEREAS, After completing his naval service, Hale Humphrey
- 4 settled in Fairfield, initially working for the Fairfield Police
- 5 Department before becoming a deputy sheriff with the Solano
- 6 County Sheriff's Office; and
- WHEREAS, Deputy Humphrey was active in social activities
- 8 in Solano County, becoming a member of the local Elks Lodge
- 9 and eventually its exalted ruler; and

WHEREAS, On March 15, 1963, following a robbery at a service station, one of the fleeing suspects killed a California Highway Patrol-Officer officer, and Deputy Humphrey, who was at a roadblock set up to apprehend the suspects, was killed in the line of duty when the suspect vehicle rammed the roadblock; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Humphrey, at the time of his death, was survived by his wife of 10 years, Elizabeth (Betty) Humphrey, and by his daughter Sherry Humphrey; and

WHEREAS, It is appropriate to commemorate Deputy Humphrey's service and ultimate sacrifice, and to designate a portion of State Highway Route 12 in Solano County in his honor; now, therefore be it

Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate thereof concurring, That the Legislature hereby designates the portion of State Highway Route 12 that constitutes the overcrossing between the City of Fairfield and the City of Suisun City between Marina Boulevard and Pennsylvania Avenue, near the south end of Union Avenue and the north end of Main Street, in the County of Solano, as the Solano County Deputy Sheriff Hale Humphrey Memorial Highway; and be it further

Resolved, That the Department of Transportation is requested to determine the cost of erecting appropriate signs, consistent with the signing requirements of the state highway system, showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs; and be it further

Resolved, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies of this resolution to the Director of Transportation and to the author for appropriate distribution.
