Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 180—Relative to the Sergeant Brian Walker Memorial Highway.

### LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 180, as amended, Obernolte. Sergeant Brian Walker Memorial Highway.

This measure would designate a specified portion of State Highway Route 247 in the County of San Bernardino as the Sergeant Brian Walker Memorial Highway. The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost of appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, Sergeant Brian L. Walker was born and raised in
- 2 San Bernardino County's high desert region; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Sergeant Walker attended Lucerne Valley High
- 4 ~~School~~ *School*, where he was an officer in the Future Farmers of
- 5 America program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Walker served as a military policeman
- 7 in the United States Army assigned to the 425th Brigade Special

1 Troops Battalion, 4th Brigade Combat Team (Airborne), 25th  
2 Infantry Division; and

3 WHEREAS, Six days after arriving for his second deployment  
4 in the Middle East, Sergeant Walker was tragically killed in  
5 Afghanistan on May 13, 2012, when a vehicle under his command  
6 was hit with an improvised explosive device, killing him and the  
7 driver of the vehicle, Private First Class Richard L. McNulty III;

9 WHEREAS, Naming a highway is but a small way to honor the  
10 bravery of Sergeant ~~Walker~~ *Walker*, who made the ultimate  
11 sacrifice so that we may enjoy the freedoms of this great nation;  
12 now, therefore, be it

13 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*  
14 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature hereby designates the  
15 portion of State Highway Route 247 in the County of San  
16 Bernardino, beginning at the intersection of State Highway Route  
17 247 and Allen Way at postmile 44.366 and continuing toward  
18 ~~Johnson Valley for five miles~~, to Camp Rock Road at postmile  
19 39.598, as the Sergeant Brian Walker Memorial Highway; and be  
20 it further

21 *Resolved*, That the Department of Transportation is requested  
22 to determine the cost of erecting the appropriate signs, consistent  
23 with the signing requirements for the state highway system,  
24 showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations  
25 from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs; and  
26 be it further

27 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies  
28 of this resolution to the Director of Transportation and to the author  
29 for appropriate distribution.
