This measure would proclaim August 8, 2016, to August 12, 2016, inclusive, as Concrete Pipe Week.

- 1 WHEREAS, Reinforced concrete pipe and precast are of vital
2 importance to sustainable communities and to the health, safety,
3 and well-being of the people of California; and
4 WHEREAS, Reinforced concrete pipe and precast products and
5 services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of the
6 concrete pipe and precast industry manufacturers, professionals,
7 engineers, managers, and employees who together are responsible
8 for and must design, manufacture, distribute, educate, and supply
9 concrete pipe and precast to public and private owners who in turn
10 build, design, and maintain transportation infrastructure, water
11 supply, water treatment systems, solid waste systems, and other
12 structures and facilities essential to modern society; and
13 WHEREAS, It is in the public interest for the residents, civic
14 leaders, and children of California to gain knowledge and maintain
15 a progressive interest and understanding of the importance of the

2 California and across the United States; and
