An act to amend Section 29632 of the Government Code, relating to local government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 214, as introduced, Beth Gaines. County charges: victims of crime.

Existing law authorizes the legislative body of a county or city to establish a program that provides reimbursement to innocent residents whose property is injured as a consequence of the actions of a peace officer detecting crime or apprehending or arresting a person, or the actions of a person resisting or avoiding arrest.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 29632 of the Government Code is
2 amended to read:
3 29632. The legislative body of a county or of a city may
4 establish a program ~~which~~ *that* provides for the reimbursement of
5 any innocent resident of the county or city, as the case may be,
6 whose property is or has been at any time subsequent to a date
7 designated by the legislative body injured or destroyed as the
8 consequence of:

- 1 (a) An act of a peace officer in the detection of crime or the
- 2 apprehension or arrest of any person for any public offense; or
- 3 (b) An act of a person in resisting or avoiding arrest.
