An act to amend Section 4150 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 222, as introduced, Achadjian. Vehicles: vehicle registration.

Existing law requires the owner of a vehicle of a type required to be registered under the Vehicle Code to submit an application for the original or renewal registration of that vehicle to the Department of Motor Vehicles upon the appropriate form furnished by the department.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4150 of the Vehicle Code is amended to
2 read:
3 4150. Application for the original or renewal registration of a
4 vehicle of a type *that is* required to be registered under this code
5 shall be made by the owner to the department upon the appropriate
6 form furnished by it and shall contain all of the following
7 *information*:
8 (a) The true, full name, business or residence and mailing
9 address, and driver's license or identification card number, if any,

- 1 of the owner, and the true, full name and business or residence or
- 2 mailing address of the legal owner, if any.
- 3 (b) The name of the county in which the owner resides.
- 4 (c) A description of the vehicle, including the following data
- 5 insofar as ~~they~~ *it* may exist:
- 6 (1) The make, model, and type of body.
- 7 (2) The vehicle identification number or any other identifying
- 8 number as may be required by the department.
- 9 (3) The date first sold by a manufacturer, remanufacturer, or
- 10 dealer to a consumer.
- 11 (d) Any other information that is reasonably required by the
- 12 department to enable it to determine whether the vehicle is lawfully
- 13 entitled to registration.
