Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 201—Relative to California Young Parents Day.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL’S DIGEST

ACR 201, as introduced, Weber. California Young Parents Day.

This measure would recognize August 25, 2016, and every August 25 thereafter, as California Young Parents Day and would urge all Californians to join in celebrating California Young Parents Day.

1 WHEREAS, Young mothers and fathers, as all families, deserve
2 dignity, tangible support, and recognition as important members
3 of California communities; and

4 WHEREAS, Young mothers and fathers, as all youth, are part
5 of the fabric of vibrant communities across California and represent
6 its future prosperity; and

7 WHEREAS, Children, youth, and young adults under 20 years
8 of age make up over a quarter of California’s population; and

9 WHEREAS, Young people of all economic backgrounds, gender
10 identities and expression, sexualities, abilities, and immigration
11 statuses have the right to parent the children they have; and

12 WHEREAS, Pregnant and parenting youth have the right, as all
13 youth, to all support needed to continue with their educational and
14 career goals, including child care, health care, housing assistance,
15 and job training and other economic opportunities; and

1 WHEREAS, Using negative language and stereotypes around
2 young parenting serves only to blame and denigrate young people
3 for their circumstances and does not reflect their realities; and

4 WHEREAS, Young people of color, whether pregnant,
5 parenting, or nonparenting, face persistent systemic inequities,
6 including, but not limited to, poverty, racism, sexism, and violence,
7 that shape and often undermine their decisionmaking and
8 aspirations; and

9 WHEREAS, Pregnant, parenting, and nonparenting youth must
10 have access to culturally relevant and gender-sensitive sexual and
11 reproductive health services and educational, material, economic,
12 and emotional support; and

13 WHEREAS, The health and wellness of young parents and their
14 children is our shared responsibility and must be reflected in our
15 state policies; now, therefore, be it

16 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
17 *thereof concurring,* That the Legislature recognizes the
18 contributions and needs of young parents and that this resolution
19 serves as a framework to inform future policy decisions that affect
20 their well being; and be it further

21 *Resolved,* That August 25, 2016, and every August 25 thereafter,
22 shall be recognized as “California Young Parents Day” and that
23 all Californians are encouraged to celebrate the occasion; and be
24 it further

25 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
26 of this resolution to the author for appropriate distribution.
