An act to amend Section 53000 of the Government Code, relating to local agencies.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 385, as introduced, Chu. Local agencies.

Existing law defines the term “legislative body” for purposes of laws relating to cities, counties, and other local agencies.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that definition.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 53000 of the Government Code is
2 amended to read:
3 53000. As used in this chapter, “legislative body” means the
4 board of supervisors in the case of a county or a city and county,
5 the city council or *the* board of trustees in the case of a city, and
6 the board of directors or other governing body in the case of a
7 district or other public agency, unless the context otherwise
8 requires.
