LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 624, as introduced, Wilk. Real estate appraisers.

Existing law, the Real Estate Appraisers' Licensing and Certification Law, regulates the licensing of real estate appraisers. That law provides that the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice sets forth the minimum standards of conduct and performance for real estate appraisers.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.
