An act to amend Section 1814 of the Vehicle Code, relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 917, as introduced, Brown. Department of Motor Vehicles: automobile registration service.

Existing law requires a person engaged in the business of examining the records of the department and supplying that information to the public for compensation to first apply for a permit.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to those provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1814 of the Vehicle Code is amended to

3 1814. ~~Any~~A person engaged in the business of examining the
4 records of the department and supplying information relative
5 ~~thereto to those records~~ to the public for compensation shall first
6 obtain a permit from the director. The director shall grant ~~such a~~
7 ~~that~~ permit when he *or she* determines that the applicant is qualified
8 and intends in good faith to carry on ~~such that~~ business, and when

- 1 the applicant files with the director a bond in the amount of five
- 2 thousand dollars (\$5,000).
