LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 975, as introduced, Frazier. California State University Contract Law.

The existing California State University Contract Law sets forth a process through which contracts for projects, as defined, that are entered into with respect to the California State University may be competitively bid, entered into, and executed.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

auxiliary organization, as defined in Section 89901 of the Education Code, and funded in whole or in part by public funds.

- 3 (b) "Service contract" means—any *a* contract for services in 4 connection with a project other than a project contract, and 5 includes, but is not limited to, contracts for architectural, 6 engineering, planning, testing, general studies, or feasibility 7 services.
- 8 (c) "Trustees" means the Trustees of the California State 9 University and their designees.
