An act to amend Section 1305.3 of the Penal Code, relating to bail.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1082, as introduced, Linder. Bail forfeiture: prosecution costs.

Existing law provides that the applicable prosecuting agency shall recover, out of forfeited bail money, the costs incurred in successfully opposing a motion to vacate the forfeiture and in collecting on the summary judgment, as specified.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to those provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 4 prosecuting agency, as the case may be, shall recover, out of the
- 5 forfeited bail money, the costs incurred in successfully opposing
- 6 a motion to vacate the forfeiture and in collecting on the summary
- 7 judgment, prior to the division of the forfeited bail money between
- 8 the cities and counties in accordance with Section 1463.
