An act to amend Section 22514 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1111, as introduced, Gatto. Vehicles: parking.

Existing law generally prohibits a person from stopping or parking a vehicle within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.  
State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22514 of the Vehicle Code is amended  
2 to read:  
3 22514. ~~No~~A person shall *not* stop, park, or leave standing-~~any~~  
4 a vehicle within 15 feet of a fire hydrant except as follows:  
5 (a) If the vehicle is attended by a licensed driver who is seated  
6 in the front seat and who can immediately move-~~such~~ *the* vehicle  
7 in case of necessity.  
8 (b) If the local authority adopts an ordinance or resolution  
9 reducing that distance. If the distance is less than 10 feet total  
10 length when measured along the curb or edge of the street, the  
11 distance shall be indicated by signs or markings.

- 1 (c) If the vehicle is owned or operated by a fire department and
- 2 is clearly marked as a fire department vehicle.
