An act to amend Section 22514 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1111, as introduced, Gatto. Vehicles: parking.

Existing law generally prohibits a person from stopping or parking a vehicle within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22514 of the Vehicle Code is amended 2 to read:
- 22514. No A person shall *not* stop, park, or leave standing any
- 4 a vehicle within 15 feet of a fire hydrant except as follows:
- 5 (a) If the vehicle is attended by a licensed driver who is seated in the front seat and who can immediately move such the vehicle in case of necessity.
- 8 (b) If the local authority adopts an ordinance or resolution 9 reducing that distance. If the distance is less than 10 feet total
- 10 length when measured along the curb or edge of the street, the
- 11 distance shall be indicated by signs or markings.

- 1 (c) If the vehicle is owned or operated by a fire department and 2 is clearly marked as a fire department vehicle.
