ASSEMBLY BILL

An act to amend Section 49123 of the Public Resources Code, relating to solid waste.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1817, as amended, Mark Stone. Solid waste: garbage and refuse disposal districts: board of directors.

Existing law authorizes the formation of garbage and refuse disposal districts under certain conditions, and requires that a board of directors of not less than 3 members be appointed for each district. Existing law authorizes members of the board of directors to receive not more than \$50 per diem for each day of actual attendance at the meetings of the board, up to \$100 in a calendar month.

This bill would ~~require that a member of~~ *authorize* a district board ~~receive to provide, by ordinance or resolution,~~ *compensation to a member of the board* in an amount not to exceed \$100 per day for each day of attendance at a meeting of the board or for each day of service rendered as director by request of the board, and would authorize a member of a district board to receive that compensation for no more than 6 days in a calendar month.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 49123 of the Public Resources Code is
2 amended to read:

3 49123. (a) A member of a district board may be ~~reimbursed~~
4 *reimbursed, subject to Sections 53232.2 and 53232.3 of the*
5 *Government Code*, for actual and necessary expenses incurred by
6 that member in the performance of official business of the district
7 as approved by the district board.

8 (b) A ~~member of a district board shall receive~~ *may provide, by*
9 *ordinance or resolution*, compensation *to a member of the board*
10 in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) per day for
11 each day of attendance at a meeting of the board or for each day
12 of service rendered as director by request of the board. A member
13 of a district board may receive compensation pursuant to this
14 subdivision for no more than six days in a calendar month.

15 (c) *For purposes of this section, the determination of whether*
16 *a member of a district board's activities on any specific day is*
17 *compensable shall be made pursuant to Article 2.3 (commencing*
18 *with Section 53232) of Chapter 2 of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title*
19 *5 of the Government Code.*

21 (d) In addition to any other compensation received pursuant to
22 this section, the chairperson of a district board and the secretary
23 of a district board, if the secretary is a member of the district board,
24 shall each receive monthly compensation as established by the
25 district board.
