An act relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2082, as introduced, Campos. Alcoholic beverages: licenses.

Existing law, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, which is administered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, regulates the application, issuance, and suspension of alcoholic beverage licenses.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to subsequently amend this bill to include provisions that would establishes a six-month probationary period for specified licenses issued under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to subsequently
- 2 amend this measure to include provisions that would establish a
- 3 six-month probationary period for the following alcoholic beverage
- 4 licenses: licenses that are transferred to another entity or individual
- 5 and are currently under review by the Department of Alcoholic
- 6 Beverage Control for conducting illicit activities; licenses that are
- 7 sold to another entity or individual and are currently under review
- 8 by the department for conducting illicit activities; and licenses that

1 are sold or transferred to another entity or individual that has been
2 convicted of conducting illicit activities under the Alcoholic
3 Beverage Control Act. The six-month probationary period would
4 include a rapid license revocation process that may be used if the
5 licensee violates a regulation issued under, or a requirement of,
6 the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.
