An act to amend Section 1802 of the Military and Veterans Code, relating to veterans.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2267, as introduced, Dahle. Veterans: solicitation.

Existing law makes it a misdemeanor to use funds that were solicited for the benefit of any veteran or veterans' association for purposes other than those represented in the solicitation.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1802 of the Military and Veterans Code
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 1802. Any person who solicits funds for the benefit of any
- 4 veteran or veterans' association and who uses ~~such~~ *these* funds for
- 5 purposes other than those represented in the solicitation is guilty
- 6 of a misdemeanor.
