An act to amend Section 20200 of the Water Code, relating to water.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2515, as introduced, Weber. Water districts: financial supervision. Existing law provides for the compensation of members of a board of directors of a water district, as defined.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change in the definition of a water district.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20200 of the Water Code is amended to
2 read:
3 20200. As used in this chapter, “water district” means ~~any a~~
4 district or other political subdivision, other than a city or county,
5 a primary function of which is the irrigation, reclamation, or
6 drainage of land or the diversion, storage, management, or
7 distribution of water primarily for domestic, municipal, agricultural,
8 industrial, recreation, fish and wildlife enhancement, flood control,
9 or power production purposes. “Water districts” include, but are
10 not limited to, irrigation districts, county water districts, California
11 water districts, water storage districts, reclamation districts, county
12 waterworks districts, drainage districts, water replenishment

1 districts, levee districts, municipal water districts, water
2 conservation districts, community services districts, water
3 management districts, flood control districts, flood control and
4 floodwater conservation districts, flood control and water
5 conservation districts, water management agencies, water agencies,
6 and public utility districts formed pursuant to Division 7
7 (commencing with Section 15501) of the Public Utilities Code.
