- that are considered rare and Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis is one

- causing progressive, incurable lung disease; and 5
- 6 WHEREAS, Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis progresses quickly, 7
- often causing disability or death within a few short years; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In many cases there is no identified cause of 9 Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis; and
- WHEREAS, Approximately 132,000 people in the United States 10
- are estimated to have Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis; and 11
- WHEREAS, Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis may be 5 to 10 12
- times more prevalent than previously thought because Idiopathic 13
- Pulmonary Fibrosis is often misdiagnosed and under diagnosed; 14
