Senate Resolution No. 87—Relative to California Pedestrian Safety Month.

- 1 WHEREAS, In 2015, 813 pedestrians were killed on California 2 roadways; and
- WHEREAS, Between 2006 and 2015, 6,939 people died in pedestrian-related traffic incidents in California; and
- WHEREAS, Pedestrian fatalities account for nearly 25 percent 6 of all roadway deaths in California; and
- WHEREAS, No state has more pedestrian deaths on its roadways 8 than California; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Californians are encouraged to practice safe 10 pedestrian and driving behaviors in order to reduce pedestrian-related injuries and fatalities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pedestrians and motorists should continue to be reminded about their role in ensuring the safety of all who use 13 California's roadways; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Californians are encouraged to support activities 16 associated with pedestrian safety; and
- WHEREAS, Walking provides positive mental and physical 17 18 health benefits to the pedestrian, increases personal mobility options, potentially lessens air pollution and vehicular congestion, 19
- 20 and increases community livability; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The Transportation Agency, Office of Traffic
- 22 Safety, Department of the California Highway Patrol, Department
- 23 of Transportation, and Department of Motor Vehicles are joined
- 24 in the commitment to educate the public on pedestrian safety issues
- 25 and bring an eventual end to pedestrian deaths and injuries; and
