An act to amend Section 10290.1 of the Public Contract Code, relating to public contracts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 376, as introduced, Lara. Contracting by state agencies.

Existing law authorizes state agencies, in exercising their delegation of contracting authority from the Department of General Services, to contract for specified items or services with suppliers who have multiple award schedules with the General Services Administration of the United States, as provided.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10290.1 of the Public Contract Code is
2 amended to read:
3 10290.1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in
4 exercising ~~their~~ *its* delegation of contracting authority from the
5 department, ~~a state agency~~ *agency* may contract for goods,
6 information technology, or services with suppliers who have
7 multiple award schedules with the General Services Administration
8 of the United States if the supplier is willing to extend those terms,
9 conditions, and prices. The department may also develop multiple
10 award schedules or agreements for use by state agencies in the
11 same manner.

1 (b) The department shall determine the delegation contracting
2 authority for agencies wishing to contract with suppliers who have
3 multiple award schedules. The department shall seek input from
4 both customer departments and agencies and private sector
5 suppliers.
