An act to amend Section 22350 of the Penal Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 951, as introduced, McGuire. Vehicles: speed limit.

Existing law prohibits a person from driving a vehicle upon a highway at a speed greater than is reasonable or prudent having due regard for weather, visibility, the traffic on, and the surface and width of, the highway, and in no event at a speed that endangers the safety of persons or property.

This bill would expressly prohibit a person from driving a vehicle upon a highway at a speed greater than is reasonable or prudent having due regard for objects and disabled vehicles on the side of the highway.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 22350 of the Vehicle Code is amended to read:
- 3 22350. No A person shall *not* drive a vehicle upon a highway
- 4 at a speed greater than is reasonable or prudent having due regard
- 5 for weather, visibility, the traffic on, *objects and disabled vehicles*
- 6 on the side of, and the surface and width of, the highway, and in
- 7 no event at a speed which that endangers the safety of persons or
- 8 property.
