LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1013, as introduced, Beall. Parolees: mental illness: housing. Existing law requires the Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to establish the Case Management Reentry Pilot Program for specified offenders, primarily eligible parolees, who are likely to benefit from a case management reentry strategy that is designed to address, among other things, homelessness and mental disorders.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would expand mentally ill parolees' access to supportive housing.
