The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 300 of the Streets and Highways Code is amended to read:

- 7 the routes of the state highway system serve the state's heavily
- 8 traveled rural and urban corridors, that they connect the
- 9 communities and regions of the state, and that they serve the state's
- 10 economy by connecting centers of commerce, industry, agriculture,
- 11 mineral wealth, and recreation.
