An act to amend Section 44948 of the Education Code, relating to certificated school employees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1224, as introduced, Huff. Certificated school employees: probationary employees: dismissal or suspension.

Under existing law, the governing board of a school district may dismiss certain probationary employees during the school year only for cause.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

1 (b) The governing board *of a school district* may suspend a probationary employee for a specified period of time without pay as an alternative to dismissal pursuant to this section. This subdivision shall apply only to probationary employees whose probationary period commenced prior to before the 1983–84 fiscal year.
