An act to amend Section 6502.7 of the Government Code, relating to joint powers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1254, as introduced, Morrell. Joint powers: authorization.

Existing law authorizes 2 or more public agencies that have the authority to identify, plan for, monitor, control, regulate, dispose of, or abate liquid, toxic, or hazardous wastes or hazardous materials, by agreement, to form a joint powers authority to exercise any power common to the contracting parties.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

4 bodies, two or more public agencies ~~which~~ *that* have the authority

6 liquid, toxic, or hazardous wastes or hazardous materials may, by
7 agreement, jointly exercise any of these powers common to the
8 contracting parties.
9 (b) The contracting parties may provide special services,
10 including persons specially trained, experienced, expert, and
11 competent to perform these special services.
