An act to amend Section 20460 of the Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1319, as introduced, Pan. Public Employees' Retirement System. Existing law, the Public Employees' Retirement Law (PERL), establishes the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS), which provides a defined benefit to members of the system, based on final compensation, credited service, and age at retirement, subject to certain variations. PERL authorizes a public agency to contract to make its employees members of PERS, but prohibits a public agency doing so within three years of termination of a previous contract.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes in the provisions regarding public agency participation in PERS by contract, as described above.
