

ASSEMBLY BILL

Introduced by Assembly Member Cannella

January 19, 1995

An act to amend Section 22009.03 of the Government Code, relating to public employees, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 166, as introduced, Cannella. Public employees: Medicare.

Existing law authorizes the State Teachers' Retirement System, until July 1, 1995, to apply to the Board of Administration of the Public Employees' Retirement System for elections among certificated employees who are members of the State Teachers' Retirement System for the election of Medicare coverage.

This bill would extend that date to July 1, 1999, and would repeal the provision on January 1, 2000.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

Vote: $\frac{2}{3}$. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22009.03 of the Government
2 Code is amended to read:

1 22009.03. "Public agency" also includes a school
 2 district, a county superintendent of schools, and a
 3 regional occupational center or program established
 4 pursuant to Article 1 (commencing with Section 6500) of
 5 Chapter 5 of Division 7 of Title 1, with respect to
 6 employees eligible for membership in the State Teachers'
 7 Retirement System.

8 This section ~~shall become operative on July 1, 1990, and~~
 9 shall become inoperative on July 1, ~~1995 1999~~, and, as of
 10 January 1, ~~1999 2000~~, is repealed, unless a later enacted
 11 statute, which becomes effective on or before January 1,
 12 ~~1999 2000~~, deletes or extends the dates on which it
 13 becomes inoperative and is repealed.

14 SEC. 2. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the
 15 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or
 16 safety within the meaning of Article IV of the
 17 Constitution and shall go into immediate effect. The facts
 18 constituting the necessity are:

19 In order to continue the Medicare coverage of
 20 certificated school employees, this act must take effect
 21 immediately.
